CleanTECH San Diego is pleased to support car2go's efforts in pursuing an electric vehicle carsharing program in San Diego.

CleanTECH San Diego is a nonprofit trade association with a mission to accelerate San Diego as a world leader in the cleantech economy. We have a broad and diverse membership that includes private sector members such as Bank of America, Viridity Energy, Waste Management, Honeywell, Synthetic Genomics, Kyocera Solar, as well as local governments, non-governmental agencies, universities and research institutes. We are immensely interested in enabling technologies to ensure that we maximize the clean energy potential in our region.

As you well know, the largest electric vehicle and transportation project in U.S. history is well underway. A \$99.8 million grant from the U.S. Department of Energy is supporting electric vehicle projects across the county, including San Diego. Along with SDG&E, we are preparing for the deployment of over 2,000 electric vehicles in the region and currently building the charging infrastructure to support them. The car2go EV pilot project is an outstanding opportunity to showcase this large corporate investment that capitalizes on the benefit of the EV Project's infrastructure development.

In addition, Mayor Jerry Sanders joined clean energy leaders, including CleanTECH San Diego, to launch Smart City San Diego- a collaborative combining the resources of a broad mix of organizations to develop and implement local initiatives that will improve the San Diego region's energy independence, empower consumers, reduce greenhouse gas emissions, and drive economic growth.
